

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1

Arrival at Haridwar – Thrilling Adventures in Rishikesh



Arrive early morning at Haridwar Railway Station.

Transfer to Rishikesh via a scenic drive.

Check-in and freshen up at a riverside campsite.

Activities:

- 16 km white-water rafting on the Ganges with certified instructors.
- · Leisure time or riverside relaxation in the afternoon.
- Evening hi-tea with cookies (6:00 PM).
- Bonfire with music and vegetarian snacks (7:30 PM).
- Vegetarian dinner (9:00 PM).

Accommodation: Alpine tents or hotel at riverside campsite.

Meals: Lunch, Hi-Tea, Dinner.

Day 2 Scenic Drive to Mori/Sankri – Gateway to the Himalayas



Early breakfast at Rishikesh.

Road journey to Mori or Sankri village in the Himalayas.

Enjoy views of rivers, pine forests, and quaint towns en route.


Reach Mori/Sankri by evening.

Explore the local village and its serene setting.

Accommodation: Guesthouse or homestay.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner.

Trek from Mori/Sankri to Juda-ka-Talab (3–4 Hours)



Start the trek from Sankri via Saur village after breakfast.

3–4 hour moderate hike through dense pine and oak forests.

Witness snow-capped Himalayan peaks en route.

Reach Juda-ka-Talab, a beautiful alpine lake.

Camp slightly uphill in nearby meadows.

Accommodation: Alpine tents in the forest clearing.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch or Packed Lunch, Hi-Tea, Dinner.

Trek from Juda-ka-Talab to Kedarkantha Base Camp (4–5 Hours)



Begin ascent after breakfast.

Trek through open forests and snowy meadows.

Breathtaking panoramic mountain views along the way.


Reach base camp in vast open meadows with a stream and mountain views.

Ideal spot for photography and relaxation.

Accommodation: Tents at Kedarkantha Base Camp.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch or Packed Lunch, Dinner.

Summit Kedarkantha Peak & Descend to Juda-ka-Talab / Sankri (Trek: 6–7 Hours)



Start early (pre-dawn) for summit push after light breakfast.

2–3 hour steep climb to Kedarkantha summit.

Enjoy 360° views of Yamunotri, Gangotri, and Kinnaur Kailash ranges.

Celebrate and click photos at the summit.

Descend back to base camp and further down to Juda-ka-Talab or Sankri (based on conditions).

Accommodation: Tents at Juda-ka-Talab or guesthouse at Sankri.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch or Packed Lunch, Hi-Tea, Dinner.

Trek to Sankri – Drive to Mussoorie & Leisure Day



Early morning descent to Sankri after breakfast.

Drive to Mussoorie, the "Queen of the Hills."

Check-in at a luxury hotel/campsite.

Leisure time to visit:

Mall Road

Kempty Falls (optional)

Accommodation: Hotel or luxury campsite in Mussoorie.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Nature Walk & Departure with Beautiful Memories



Wake up to peaceful natural surroundings.

Optional self-guided nature walk in nearby trails.

Group breakfast.

Drive back to Haridwar Railway Station.

End of trip with cherished memories and photographs.

Meals: Breakfast.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- All sanitized internal transportation. Transport provided by Sumo / Bolero / Tempo Travel.

- Mussoorie sightseeing (Mall Road, Kempty Falls, etc.)
- Others: Cloakroom facility available at base camp for excess luggage storage.

GUIDELINES & TERMS

- Acceptance: By making any payment or booking, you agree to all terms listed on the official website. No verbal, phone, or social media confirmations or agreements are valid.
- Booking & Payment: Confirmations only via official email., Payments must be made through digital and traceable modes (net banking, cards, UPI). Cash payments are not accepted except approved cheques cleared in advance. Prices quoted are valid for 24 hours or as stated, and can change until full payment is received.
- Advance Booking & Group Size: Book at least 20 days before the trip start date. Train/flight tickets require bookings 10 to
 70 days ahead as per company's timelines. Trips may be canceled or merged if the minimum number of participants is
 not met; refunds are issued as vouchers, not cash. All communications must be through the registered email used for
 booking. Phone calls, WhatsApp, texts, or social media messages will not be considered or processed.
- Non-Transferability: Bookings and tickets are non-transferable and non-renamable after confirmation and full payment. Unauthorized transfers or name changes may lead to cancellation without refunds.
- Changes & Rescheduling: Only one rescheduling allowed per booking, with a 25% rescheduling fee, if done more than 10 days before departure. Additional changes are treated as cancellations.
- Train/Flight Policies: Subject to railway/airline rules; no guaranteed seats or boarding points. No refunds or compensation for seat allocations or boarding changes.
- Participant Conduct & Safety: Follow guide and company instructions strictly for safety and group harmony. Alcohol, tobacco, or intoxicants are prohibited during tours; violations lead to removal without refund. Abusive or threatening behavior results in immediate blacklisting and loss of services.
- Health & Insurance: Valid travel and medical insurance is mandatory. Disclose all pre-existing medical conditions at booking. Non-disclosure may lead to denied service or removal without refund.
- Minors: Participants under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times. Unaccompanied minors' bookings may be rejected or canceled without refund.
- Liabilities & Force Majeure: Liability limited to payment amount only. No liability for indirect or consequential losses or for delays caused by events outside the company's control (natural disasters, strikes, government orders). Third-party vendor liabilities are limited to recoveries from those parties.
- Dispute Resolution: Written notice required 30 days before seeking legal remedies. Jurisdiction lies exclusively with courts in Mansa or Gandhinagar, Gujarat, India.
- Additional Policies: Entry fees, permits, and local taxes are usually extra and must be paid by the client. Itineraries are indicative and may change due to weather, logistics, or safety reasons without refund. Group transport leaves on schedule; late or no-show participants forfeit transport without compensation. Clients are responsible for rented gear; damage or loss is charged accordingly. Respect local culture, environment, and communities; violations may lead to removal. The company may photograph or record tours for promotional use; clients consent to this without compensation. Personal data is handled per applicable laws; the company is not liable for unauthorized breaches beyond their control.
