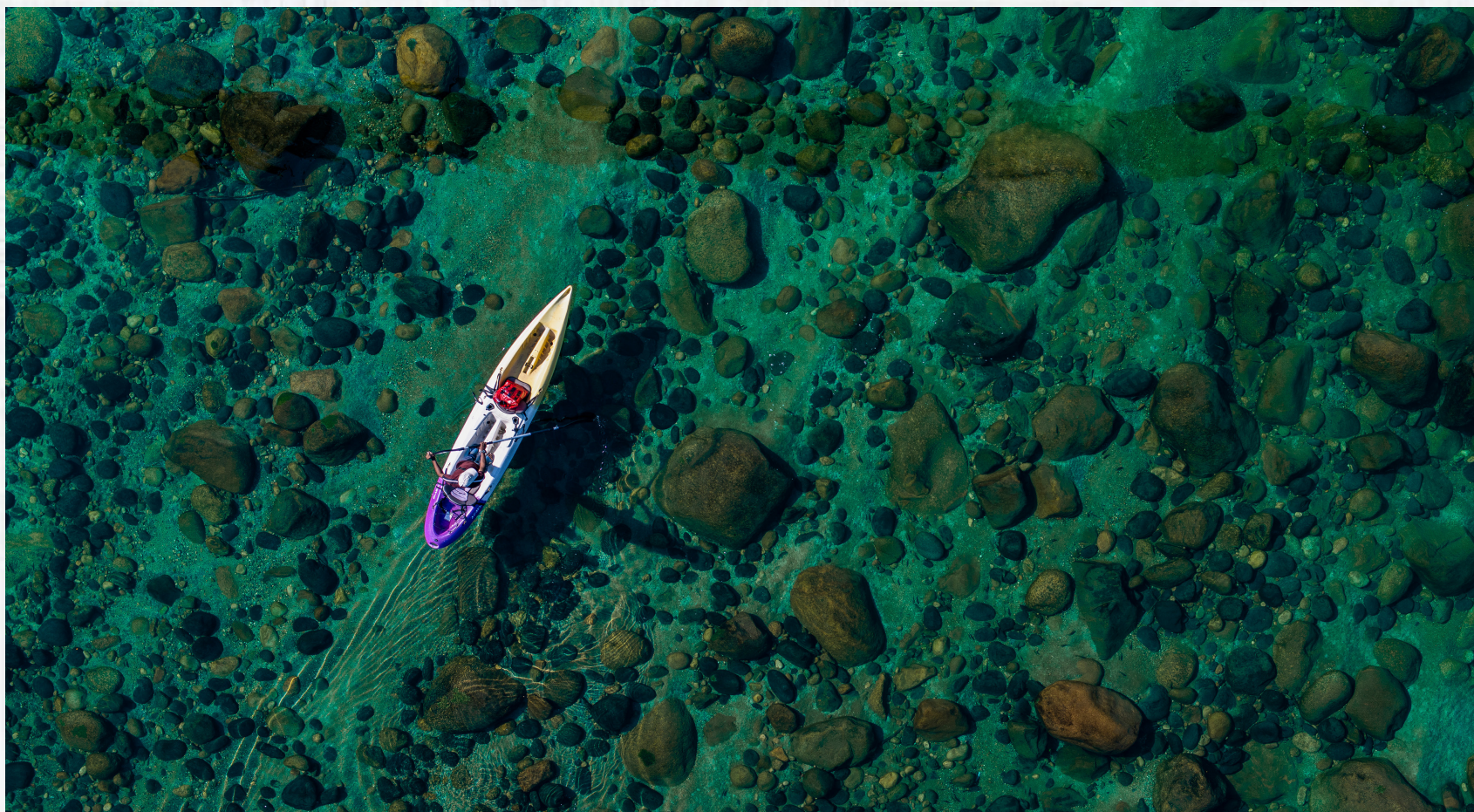

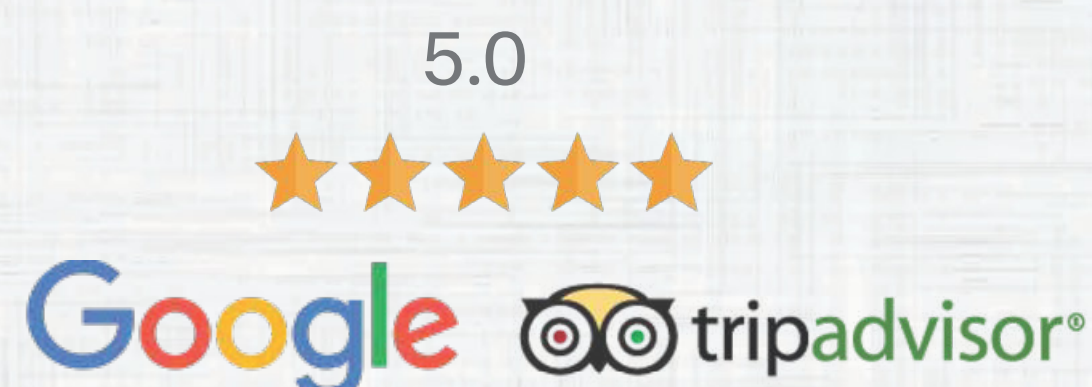

# DETAILED ITINERARY

## Day 1 Guwahati Arrival – Transfer To Shillong



All Travelers Must Arrive At Guwahati Airport On Or Before 12:00 For Group Assembly And Basic Verification. Departure Will Be Scheduled By 12:30.

Guwahati To Shillong Transfer. Distance: Approx 100 Km.

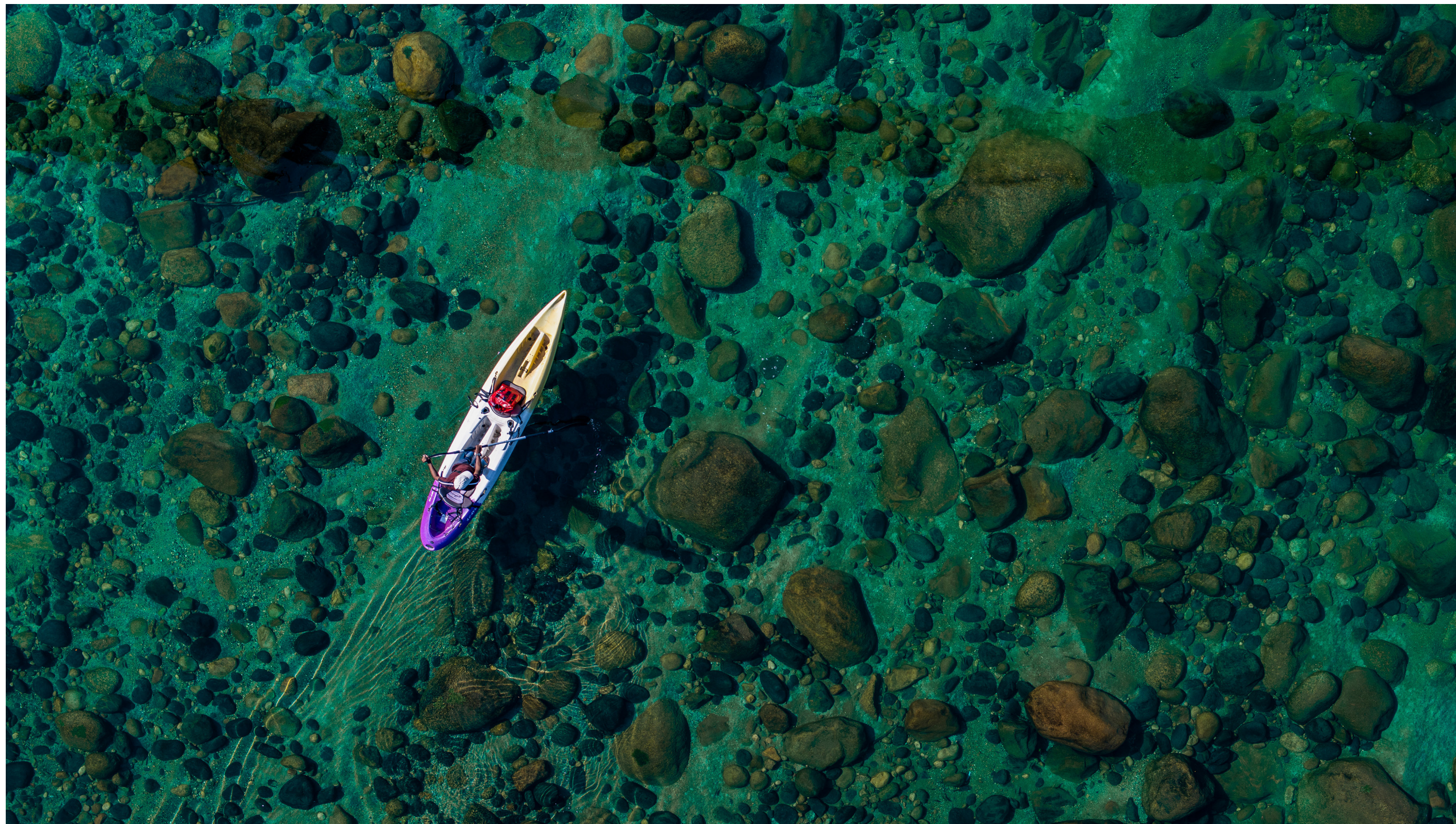
Drive Duration: 03:00–04:00 Hours (Subject To Traffic And Road Conditions).

Proceed Towards Shillong Through Scenic Hill Roads And Gradual Elevation Into The Khasi Hills Of Meghalaya. En Route Halt At: Umiam Lake (Barapani) – A Majestic Reservoir Surrounded By Pine-Covered Hills. Boating And Water Activities Are Optional And Subject To Availability. Charges Are Payable Directly.

Arrival In Shillong By Evening. Hotel Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

Meals – Dinner

## Day 2 Shillong – Mawlynnong – Dawki – Living Root Bridge & Umngot River



Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Shillong By 07:30.

Shillong To Mawlynnong Village Transfer. Distance: Approx 80–90 Km.

Drive Duration: 02:30–03:00 Hours (Subject To Road And Weather Conditions).

Visit Mawlynnong Village, Known For Its Clean Surroundings And Traditional Khasi Settlement Layout. Walk Through The Village Pathways And Visit The Famous Living Root Bridge – A Naturally Formed Bridge Created From Intertwined Rubber Tree Roots Over Several Years.

Proceed Towards Dawki Near The India–Bangladesh Border.

Visit The Crystal Clear Umngot River, Known For Its Transparent Water Where Boats Appear To Float On Glass. Boating Is Optional And Subject To Weather And River Conditions. Charges Are Payable Directly.

Short Stop At The Indo–Bangladesh Border View Point (Subject To Local Security Conditions).

Return To Shillong By Evening. Expected Arrival Between 18:00–19:00.

# Day 3

## Shillong – Cherrapunji – Waterfalls & Scenic Highlands



Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Shillong By 08:00.

Shillong To Cherrapunji (Sohra) Transfer. Distance: Approx 55 Km.

Drive Duration: 01:30–02:00 Hours (Subject To Road And Weather Conditions).

Cherrapunji Is Known For Its Dramatic Cliffs, Deep Valleys, And Heavy Rainfall.

Visit:

- Eco Park – Offering Panoramic Valley Views.
- Dainthlen Falls – A Scenic Waterfall With Unique Rock Formations.
- Nohkalikai Falls – One Of The Tallest Plunge Waterfalls In India.
- Seven Sisters Falls – A Multi-Stream Waterfall Visible During Good Flow Season.
- Mawsmai Cave – A Limestone Cave With Natural Rock Formations (Subject To Entry Timings).

After Sightseeing, Return Towards Shillong. En Route Visit:

- Elephant Falls – A Multi-Tiered Waterfall.
- Shillong Peak – The Highest Point In Meghalaya Offering Panoramic Views (Subject To Security Clearance).

Arrival In Shillong By Evening.

## Day 4 Shillong – Tezpur – Museum & Temple Visit



Breakfast At Hotel. Early Departure From Shillong By 05:30.

Shillong To Tezpur Transfer. Distance: Approx 320–350 Km.

Drive Duration: 07:00–08:00 Hours (Subject To Road And Traffic Conditions).

Visit:

- Don Bosco Museum – A Cultural Museum Showcasing The Traditions, History, And Ethnic Diversity Of Northeast India.
- Maha Mrityunjay Temple – A Prominent Shiva Temple Known For Its Tall Shiva Statue.

Continue The Journey Towards Tezpur Along The Brahmaputra Valley Plains. Arrival In Tezpur By Evening. Hotel Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

If Time Permits, Short Visit To:

- Mahabhairab Temple
- Agnigarh Hill – A Hilltop Viewpoint Overlooking The Brahmaputra River.

Meals – Breakfast, Dinner

Overnight Stay – Tezpur

# Day 5 | Tezpur – Dirang – Himalayan Valley Transition



Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Tezpur By 07:00.

Tezpur To Dirang Transfer. Distance: Approx 140 Km.

Drive Duration: 05:00–06:00 Hours (Subject To Road Conditions And Checkpoints).

After Crossing Into Arunachal Pradesh (ILP Verification At Entry Gate), The Route Gradually Ascends Through Mountain Roads And River Valleys.

En Route Visit:

- Tipi Orchid Research Centre – Known For Its Collection Of Native Orchid Species Of Arunachal Pradesh.

Arrival In Dirang By Afternoon. Hotel Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

Post Arrival Visit:

- Sangti Valley – A Scenic Valley With River Views And Open Landscapes.
- Dirang Dzong – A Historic Fort-Style Settlement Reflecting Local Architecture.
- Dirang Hot Water Spring (Subject To Accessibility).

Evening Kept Light For Acclimatization Before Higher Altitude Travel.

Meals – Breakfast, Dinner

# Day 6

## Dirang – Sela Pass – Tawang – High Altitude Mountain Crossing



Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Dirang By 08:00.

Dirang To Tawang Transfer. Distance: Approx 130 Km.

Drive Duration: 06:00–07:00 Hours (Subject To Weather, Road Conditions, And Army Checkpoints).

En Route Visit:

- Sela Pass – Located At Approx 4,170 Meters (13,700 Ft). A High Altitude Mountain Pass Known For Alpine Landscapes And Seasonal Snow. Short Halt For Photography (Weather Permitting).
- Jaswant Garh War Memorial – Memorial Dedicated To Rifleman Jaswant Singh Rawat Of The 1962 Indo-China War.
- Nuranang Falls – Also Known As Jang Falls, A Scenic Waterfall Located Near Jang Village.

Optional Visit: Bumla Pass (Subject To Army Permit Approval, Weather Conditions, And Road Accessibility. Local Vehicle Charges Payable Directly As Per Local Union Rates).

Arrival In Tawang By Late Afternoon. Hotel Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

Evening Reserved For Rest And Acclimatization Due To Higher Altitude.

Meals – Breakfast, Dinner

# Day 7

## Tawang – Monastery & War Memorial Exploration



Breakfast At Hotel.

Local Sightseeing In Tawang.

Visit:

- Tawang Monastery (Namgyal Lhatse) – The Largest Monastery In India And One Of The Most Important Buddhist Monastic Institutions In The Region. The Monastery Offers Panoramic Views Of Tawang Valley And Houses Ancient Buddhist Scriptures And Artifacts.
- Gyangong Ani Gompa – A Peaceful Nunnery Located Amidst Scenic Mountain Surroundings.
- Tawang War Memorial – Dedicated To The Brave Soldiers Of The 1962 Indo-China War. Light And Sound Show Is Subject To Operational Schedule.

Evening Free For Local Market Visit Or Leisure Time (Subject To Time And Weather Conditions).

Meals – Breakfast, Dinner

# Day 8

## Tawang – Bomdila – Monastery & Himalayan Views



Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Tawang By 08:00.

Tawang To Bomdila Transfer. Distance: Approx 170 Km.

Drive Duration: 07:00–08:00 Hours (Subject To Road, Weather, And Sela Pass Conditions).

The Route Descends Gradually From High Altitude Terrain Into The Mid-Himalayan Region With Scenic Valley And Forest Views.

Arrival In Bomdila By Late Afternoon. Hotel Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

Post Arrival Visit:

- Bomdila Monastery – A Peaceful Monastery Offering Panoramic Views Of The Surrounding Himalayan Ranges.
- Bomdila View Point – Known For Clear Day Views Of Snow-Clad Peaks.
- Local Apple Orchards (Seasonal And Subject To Accessibility).

Evening Free For Short Walk Around Local Market Area (Time Permitting).

Meals – Breakfast, Dinner

## Day 9

### Bomdila – Kaziranga – Wildlife Corridor Transfer



Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Bomdila By 07:00.

Bomdila To Kaziranga National Park Transfer. Distance: Approx 240–260 Km.  
Drive Duration: 07:00–08:00 Hours (Subject To Road And Traffic Conditions).

The Route Gradually Descends From The Himalayan Foothills Into The Plains Of Assam Along The Brahmaputra Valley.

Arrival At Kaziranga By Late Afternoon. Hotel / Lodge / Resort Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

If Time Permits, Visit:

- Kaziranga Orchid and Biodiversity Park (Subject To Operational Hours).
- Nearby Tea Garden Area For Short Walk And Photography (Subject To Accessibility).

Meals – Breakfast, Dinner

# Day 10 Kaziranga – Jeep Safari & Biodiversity Experience



Early Morning Departure For Jeep Safari At Kaziranga National Park (Safari Timings And Zone Allocation As Per Forest Department Regulations).

Kaziranga Is A UNESCO World Heritage Site And The Natural Habitat Of The Great One-Horned Rhinoceros. The Park Also Supports Wild Elephants, Wild Water Buffaloes, Swamp Deer, And A Significant Population Of Royal Bengal Tigers (Sightings Not Guaranteed). It Is Also A Recognized Birding Destination With Numerous Migratory And Resident Bird Species.

Return To Resort For Breakfast And Rest.

Elephant Safari Is Not Included In The Package. It Is Optional And Subject To Availability. Charges Are Payable Directly.

Afternoon Proceed For Second Jeep Safari (Subject To Forest Department Slot Availability And Weather Conditions).

Evening Return To Hotel. Leisure Time.

Breakfast At Hotel. Departure From Kaziranga National Park By 08:00.

Kaziranga To Guwahati Transfer. Distance: Approx 200 Km.

Drive Duration: 04:30–05:30 Hours (Subject To Road And Traffic Conditions).

Arrival In Guwahati. Hotel Check-In On Double Sharing Basis.

Visit:

- Srimanta Sankardev Kalakshetra – A Cultural Complex Showcasing The Art, History, And Traditions Of Assam.

Evening Optional Activity:

- Brahmaputra River Cruise (Direct Payment And Subject To Operational And River Conditions).

Time Permitting, Travelers May Visit Local Markets Known For Assam Tea And Traditional Assam Silk Products.

## Day 12 Guwahati – Kamakhya Temple Visit – Departure



Breakfast At Hotel. Check-Out By 09:00.

Visit:

- Kamakhya Temple – One Of The Oldest And Most Revered Shakti Peethas In India, Located On Nilachal Hill. Darshan Is Subject To Temple Queue And Local Conditions.

Time Permitting, Short Visit To:

- Umananda Temple On Peacock Island (Subject To Ferry Operations And Time Availability).

Final Transfer To Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport.

Scheduled Drop Time – 12:00 (Afternoon).

Travelers Are Advised To Book Return Flights After 15:00 To Avoid Any Operational Delays.

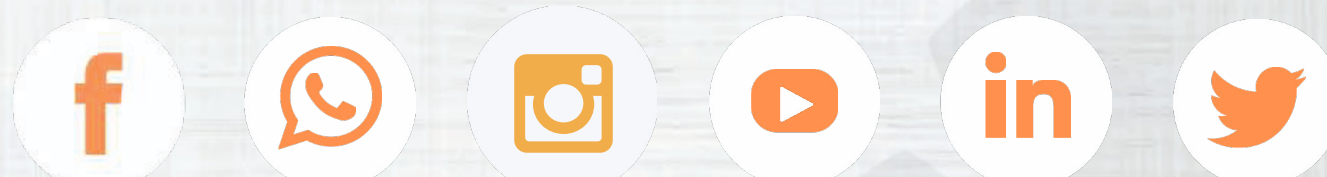

2. **Booking & Payment:** Confirmations Only Via Official Email. Payments Must Be Made Through Digital And Traceable Modes (Net Banking, Cards, UPI). Cash Payments Are Not Accepted Except Approved Cheques Cleared In Advance. Prices Quoted Are Valid For 24 Hours Or As Stated, And Can Change Until Full Payment Is Received.
3. **Advance Booking & Group Size:** Book At Least 20 Days Before The Trip Start Date. Train/Flight Tickets Require Bookings 10 To 70 Days Ahead As Per Company's Timelines. Trips May Be Canceled Or Merged If The Minimum Number Of Participants Is Not Met; Refunds Are Issued As Vouchers, Not Cash. All Communications Must Be Through The Registered Email Used For Booking. Phone Calls, WhatsApp, Texts, Or Social Media Messages Will Not Be Considered Or Processed.
4. **Non-Transferability:** Bookings And Tickets Are Non-Transferable And Non-Renamable After Confirmation And Full Payment. Unauthorized Transfers Or Name Changes May Lead To Cancellation Without Refunds.

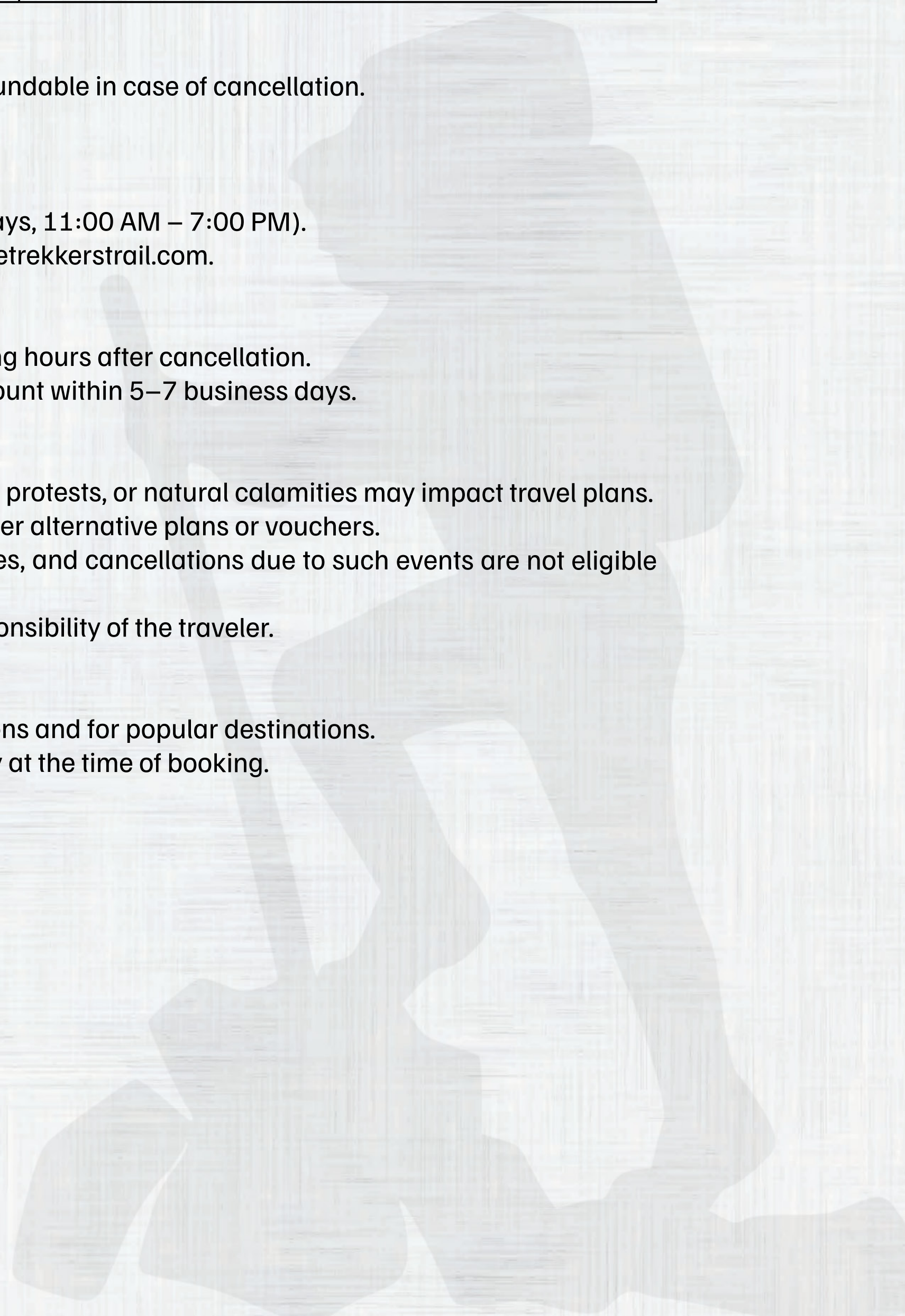
